The full makeover features a new Capital Blue Cross Connect health and wellness center on the ground floor of the facility at 1221 Hamilton St., Allentown.

It is Capital's second Connect center in the region, joining the one at the Promenade Shops at Saucon Valley.

"This is more than an investment in a building," said Capital Blue Cross President and CEO Todd Shamash. "It's part of our continuing investment in a vibrant region we consider home. Capital has built a trusted relationship with the Lehigh Valley by going the extra mile to improve the health and well-being of the region's people and communities.

The latest Capital Blue Cross Connect anchors the newly renovated headquarters, providing street-level entry to a reimagined, wide-open space where visitors can conveniently access a variety of wellness services. The overall building renovations include a complete interior remodeling and a fresh façade featuring Capital Blue Cross' new logo.
